GENERAL INFORMATION

Swimming New Zealand and the Banana Boat New Zealand Ocean Swim Series have partnered to host the 2025 NZ Secondary School Open Water Championships within the Legend of the Lake swim.

Event Safety and Rules will be governed by the Banana Boat New Zealand Ocean Swim Series guidelines.

This meet is open to financial, registered (at the time of competition) Swimming New Zealand club swimmers, competitive swimmers and any person who is enrolled at Secondary Schools in New Zealand.

Distances, Age Groups and Eligibility

The event offers the following distances:

- 3.5km
- 1000m
- 500m

Swimmers wanting to enter multiple distances can do so at their own responsibility. Please note that swimmers must attend the safety briefing of each distance entered. Check safety briefings and start times before entering.

Age Groups for the Championships are 12-13yrs, 14-15yrs and 16-19yrs, with a female and male division for each of the above Age Groups.

Eligibility Age as at 29 March 2025

There are no qualification times for the Championships; entries open to all schools in New Zealand with year 9-13 students.

Homeschooled students are eligible to participate but must align to a secondary school for the Championships.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Entries close on Sunday 23 March 2025 at 11:59pm

Late Entries will not be accepted. No refunds for any withdrawals (including medical) will apply once entries have closed.

Entry Process

All entries **MUST** be completed online and through the Banana Boat NZ Ocean Swim Series registration portal.

School Sanctioning Form

All entries must be confirmed/sanctioned by the swimmers' Secondary School.

Following entries closing, schools will be sent a list of their students together with the Sanctioning Jotform, which must be completed no later than 5:00pm on Thursday 27 March 2025.

Foreign Entries

No international visitor entries will be accepted for this championship. Visitors may enter the publicly available event through the Banana Boat NZ Ocean Swim Series.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

Briefings

Briefings are compulsory and must be attended by all swimmers prior to commencing. They include important information about safety, start and finish procedures and any other important information.

Swim Caps

Swim caps are provided as part of your entry and must be worn as a Health and Safety measure.

Wetsuits

Wetsuits are optional for all events.

Wave Starts

All events are split into wave starts seeding you with swimmers of similar ability/speed. This is calculated by the estimated swim time selected during your entry process.

Timing Chips

Electronic timing straps will be used for these championships. Swimmers will be charged if any straps are lost/not returned.

Race Pack Collection

These can be collected from the registration tent at the times specified on the Legend of the Lake webpage on the Banana Boat NZ Ocean Swim Series website.

Results

Results for these championships will be posted on the SNZ website and BBNZOSS website as soon as practicable after the race.

Medals

Medals will be awarded to the top three swimmers in each age group category per gender.

Please note that students will also be eligible for medals in the Legend of the Lake event.

Top School Trophy

Points will be awarded to top 10 placings in each age group category per gender to determine the Top School Trophy.

Anti-Doping

All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.



OTHER INFORMATION

Parking

Event Parking will be limited in the event areas, please allow enough time to park further away if required.

We ask for your cooperation to follow any directions or instructions by event staff.

Please drive carefully and slow around the event site as (young) swimmers will be walking around and possibly on roadside.
